For some reason recently though thoroughly cleaning, conjunctivitis has managed to find its way into one of the rooms. I know this makes us sad because I know how hard the girls throughout the nursery work keeping their areas tidy and clean. But it is a childhood illness and it is out of our control. We are updating our policy to say if the child has had antibiotic drops for 48 hours and are not ill then they may come in. The public health state there is no reason to keep children off school or nursery. If your child is ill please do not bring them to nursery. We would like to try and keep nursery as healthy as possible.

Buttercups Room

This month in Buttercups we have been singing lots of nursery rhymes and teaching the children the actions to go with the songs. We have been playing lots outside and learning how to climb up the steps to the climbing frame. We have been encouraging the children to talk as much as possible as communication is very important especially after lockdown. We are offering choices and allowing the children to pick what they want to eat and drink at meal times. We have been practising colours a lot and the children have picked them up very quickly. As always we have been getting very messy and exploring with different textures. Next term we are going to be focusing on the book 'Handa's surprise'.

Bluebells Room

Next term we are going to be focusing the activities around Elmer the elephant.

We are going to do dinosaurs in cereal and using rollers to make different sounds. Decorating flowers with different types of seeds and sensory bear hunt activities. The children have enjoyed getting involved in role play where they have dressed up as doctors, builders and teachers looking after the babies. Practicing our pouring skill with pots and pan in the rice and water and using Lego in paint to make different patterns. Could you please make sure you are putting enough spare clothes in the children's bags, mainly underwear and socks please.

Peonies Room

This month, we have been busy learning about healthy foods and teaching the children where food comes from and talking about different animals. We have been using our senses in our weekly cooking lessons. We have been making pizza and getting the children to look closely at all of the individual ingredients. We have been learning about personal hygiene and have been washing the dollies, practising brushing big teeth and talking about why it is important to wash hands. We have started to learn about sun safety as the weather will start to get warmer soon. Please could you make sure you send into nursery a labelled sun cream and hat for when the weather gets warmer.

We have been very busy doing lots of fun activities such as painting, mark making and physical activities like jumping on the trampoline and playing in the garden. The children have enjoyed the book Handa's Surprise. The children have also been enjoying writing their own name. We have also been practicing how to get our coats and shoes on by ourselves.
